COMMUNITY PROFILE

The town of Juno Beach is a quiet oceanfront community with a small-town atmosphere tucked between the Atlantic Ocean and the Intracoastal Waterway. Located on a barrier island along the Atlantic coastal ridge just north of West Palm Beach, the town was incorporated in 1953 and is situated in Northern Palm Beach County.

Offshore lie Spanish ship wrecks dating from the late 1500's to early 1600's and the area itself has a native civilization dating from 500 B.C.

Year-round sunny skies and balmy tropical temperatures make Juno Beach an ideal place to call home. Nationally known golf courses, tennis courts, county parks, shopping, and art galleries surround the area and offer a haven of recreational pursuits. The town offers an ultimate playground for water sports like water-skiing, kayaking, wind surfing, parasailing, snorkeling, scuba diving, and more with comfortable year-round temperatures. Boating enthusiasts can enjoy the many marinas along the Intracoastal Waterway and Atlantic Ocean inlets which offer powerboat and sailboat rentals. Proximity to Gulf Stream waters offers a wide variety of deep-sea fishing.

The Juno Beach Fishing Pier is a beautiful 990-foot pier which includes two shade structures, fish cleaning tables, and food concessions. The town is also home to Loggerhead Park, which features nature trails, a guarded beach, and a children's play area. Lake Walk is the most extensive and visible beautification project in the history of the town and features landscaping and lighting around Pelican Lake . From May to September each year, guides introduce newcomers to turtle watching as the sea turtles return to lay their eggs with 1,000 nesting per mile. As a community unsurpassed in scenic beauty and concerned with the local ecology and unsurpassed, it's no surprise that approximately 43% of Juno Beach is either county park land or environmentally sensitive lands.

The area of Southeast Florida offers a broad variety of cultural diversions. You can discover history and art at the Jupiter Inlet Lighthouse and Museum, the South Florida Science Museum, or the Flagler Museum, or enjoy a theatrical presentation or a concert at the Kravis Center. Popular CityPlace in West Palm Beach is 30 minutes with a variety of social events, shopping, and dining. For sports enthusiasts, Roger Dean Stadium is home to the Jupiter Hammerheads and Palm Beach Cardinals as well as spring training camp for the St. Louis Cardinals and Florida Marlins. Sports fans can also root for professional teams including the Miami Dolphins, Miami Heat, Florida Marlins, and Florida Panthers in stadiums close by. For fine dining, there are many excellent restaurants in Jupiter, Boca Raton, and Palm Beach.

In Fort Lauderdale, you can enjoy a fabulous range of cultural and recreational activities and explore an eclectic array of international dining, world-class entertainment, museums, and art galleries.

Juno Beach is close to all types of shopping, from quaint antique and specialty boutiques to modern malls. For convenient one-stop shopping, the Abacoa Plaza with Publix[®] Super Market and other retail stores and conveniences is less than 10 minutes away. In charming PGA Commons, you will discover unique stores where you can count on receiving personal service from shopkeepers who remember you by name. Shopping, dining, and entertainment can be found at Downtown at The Gardens and the fabulous Gardens Mall in Palm Beach Gardens features Bloomingdale's, Saks Fifth Avenue, Nordstrom, Macy's, and over 160 fine specialty shops.
