BLX is technology engineered with basalt fibers, combining proprietary frame, grommet and grip technologies for the perfect feel. TENNIS TIP

Have you lost that special feeling? I'm referring to that special feeling in your tennis racquet.

When it comes to replacing strings in your tennis racquet the rule of thumb is to divide the number of times you place a week by the number of weeks in a year. Thus, if you play four times a week you should replace your strings every three months.

Another reason for replacing strings would be if you are experiencing any elbow or shoulder problems. Many times a racquet may be strung too tightly. This causes the vibrations in the frame to penetrate through the racquet and into your arm instead of being absorbed by the strings and frame. If you are experiencing any of these problems you might want to try the new Wilson Shock Shield System. This system consists of the new shock shield string, grip and dampener designed to help tennis elbow.

And last but not least if you are trying to regain control or add power to your game it is definitely time to restring your racquet. Remember the looser you string the racquet the more power you will generate. The tighter you string your racquet the more control you will gain from your frame. Not the opposite as often believed.
