A Convenient Place to Live

In Loudoun Valley, you will enjoy the relaxed atmosphere of country living with superior schools, excellent shopping, and a wide choice of cultural events close to home. Loudoun Valley is only 3 minutes from the Dulles Greenway, 6 minutes from Route 28, and 12 minutes from Route 7. Businesses along the Dulles Technology Corridor are within a 5-minute drive. Herndon and Leesburg can be reached in just 7 and 10 minutes, respectively. Reston is 12 minutes and Tysons Corner is 20 minutes away. Interstate 495 (the Capital Beltway) is 25 minutes from your new home. Commuting to Washington, D.C., is a 40-minute drive or a 15-minute Metrorail ride from the West Falls Church station, located just 30 minutes away. Washington Dulles International Airport can be reached in 8 minutes.



A Focus on Education

As a Loudoun Valley homeowner, you will join a community where education is given the highest priority. An impressive 93% of Loudoun County's high school students continue their education after graduation. Recently, all high schools in Loudoun County were recognized by *Newsweek* magazine as being among the *Top 1000* nationwide. Gifted programs are available at all grade levels, and the Briar Woods High School offers college Advanced Placement courses. In the Loudoun County Public School District, students consistently earn many awards and scholarships for high levels of achievement in mathematics, science, history, and music. Qualified gifted students may attend "The Governor's Magnet School for the Arts," including science, technology, and the arts.

Loudoun Valley also includes three onsite schools — the brand-new Rosa Lee Carter Elementary School and Stone Hill Middle School, as well as a high school anticipated to open in September 2011.

Superb private schools, including the Loudoun County Day School; the Madeira, Foxcroft, and St. Theresa Schools; and the Notre Dame, Flint Hill, and Chesterbrook Academies, are all within 30 minutes of Loudoun Valley. These private schools offer both primary and secondary education.

Shenandoah University in Leesburg and the Loudoun County campuses of George Washington University and Old Dominion University are less than 20 minutes away. Nearby, Northern Virginia Community College offers continuing adult education with a wide diversity of day and evening courses. The graduate centers of the University of Virginia, Marymount University, and Virginia Polytechnic Institute and State University (Virginia Tech) are also close by. George Mason University, located in Fairfax, is 40 minutes away. In addition, many excellent academic institutions in Washington, D.C., including Georgetown, American, Catholic, and George Washington Universities, are all within 60 minutes of your new home.

Loudoun Valley is close to all types of shopping, from quaint antique shops and specialty boutiques to modern malls. For convenient one-stop shopping, Wegmans — with its huge selection of gourmet foods, Market Café, cooking demonstration area, children's play area, drive-through pharmacy, and wine shop tasting area — is just 5 minutes away. Ashburn Town Square, with a wide assortment of shops, retail services, and restaurants, is just 10 minutes away.

The Dulles Town Center is just 10 minutes from Loudoun Valley, with Nordstrom, Lord & Taylor, and Macy's, along with nearly 200 shops and eateries. Loudoun Valley, offering you both an exclusive neighborhood and a classic lifestyle, is an ideal place for you and your family to make new friends. It is a tranquil place to live, offering a wide variety of activities — all right here within the community.

Nearly 300 acres of preserved open space, including public parks with miles of walking and biking trails, offer a scenic backdrop for everything from nature walks along the community's wood-chip trails, to leisurely bicycle rides along the biking trail and serious jogging along any of the pedestrian trails. The first of three planned facilities, the beautiful new Loudoun Valley Clubhouse offers three swimming pools, a fitness center, business center, and tot lot. A variety of athletic fields are available at two of three onsite schools now open, Rosa Lee Carter Elementary School and Stone Hill Middle School, with more planned when the new middle school opens for the 2011–2012 school year. An onsite retail/commercial center will offer convenient shopping and services, including a bank, dry cleaners, restaurant, and medical offices.



A Cultural and Recreational Paradise

Living at Loudoun Valley means that almost every type of recreational activity is close at hand. Several local and state parks are located within 20 minutes, including Lyndora, Claude Moore, Algonkian Regional, and Brambleton Regional Parks. At these parks, you and your family can enjoy swimming, fishing, ice skating, hiking, and picnicking. Algonkian Regional Park, located along the beautiful Potomac River, features a miniature golf course and picnic pavilions, in addition to a host of water sports, including swimming, boating, fishing, and kayaking. Equestrians, runners, hikers, bicyclists, and rollerbladers can enjoy the 45-mile W&OD (Washington & Old Dominion) Trail, just 10 minutes away. Several challenging private and semiprivate golf courses and country clubs are nearby, including Belmont, Lowe's Island, River Creek, and Lansdowne. Scenic public golf courses, including South Riding, Brambleton, Goose Creek, and Algonkian, are within 5 to 20 minutes. Several private fitness centers and exercise clubs are within 10 minutes of Loudoun Valley.



Northern Virginia in general, and Loudoun County in particular, offer a broad variety of cultural diversions. You can discover history and art at the Loudoun Museum in Leesburg, the Loudoun Heritage Farm Museum in Sterling, and the art galleries in downtown Leesburg. Theatrical presentations can be enjoyed at George Mason University's Performing Arts Center in Fairfax. Wolf Trap National Park in Vienna and the Nissan Pavilion in Bristow are wonderful outdoor venues for enjoying concerts and other musical presentations. For fine dining, there are many excellent restaurants and country inns throughout the area.
