COMMUNITY PROFILE

Established in 1758, Leesburg is the seat of government for Loudoun County. The town's rich history spans three centuries. Originally a settlement called George Town in honor of the reigning monarch of Great Britain, Leesburg was renamed to honor the influential Lee family of Virginia.

During the War of 1812, Leesburg served as the temporary capital of the United States when the valuable papers of the Federal Archives (including the Declaration of Independence and Constitution) were brought to town for safekeeping. President James Monroe resided just south of town at Oak Hill, where he wrote the Monroe Doctrine in 1823. Leesburg was the site of the Civil War Battle of Ball's Bluff, a bloody Confederate victory fought on the banks of the Potomac River. The 1861 battle claimed the life of Col. Edward Baker, a close friend of President Lincoln, and spawned a congressional committee to investigate the conduct of the war. The battlefield is marked by one of America's smallest national cemeteries.

In the 20th century, Leesburg was the home of World War II General George C. Marshall, architect of the famous Marshall Plan that re-built Europe after the war, and radio personality Arthur Godfrey, who donated land for the town's first airport.

Today Leesburg continues to serve as the center of government and commerce for Loudoun County. The Historic District was placed on the National Register of Historic Places in 1970 and cited as one of the best preserved and most picturesque downtowns in Virginia.

The Loudoun Museum located next to Town Hall in downtown Leesburg, offers a video on the history of Leesburg and Loudoun County and is an ideal place to begin your tour of Leesburg. Thomas Balch Library, located one block west of Town Hall, is a repository for historical and genealogical information for Leesburg and the surrounding area and is a popular destination for those researching their family trees.

Experience the history of Leesburg through Exploring Leesburg a guide to history and architecture, a walking tour guide book designed to bring you closer to the real character in Leesburg; the architecture, the history of the people who have passed this way before. This wonderful book is on sale at the Town Hall, Cobblestone Antiques, Bob's Family Market, the Loudoun Museum Gift Shop, Thomas Balch Library, and the LCVA Visitor Center locations.

Leesburg is the county seat of the fastest growing county in the nation. From 1990 to 2001, Leesburg doubled in population from 16,000 to 32,000. That phenomenal growth shows no sign slowing down. The town's current population is an estimated nearly 37,500 and is projected to be 45,000 by 2010.

Bles Park

The 124-acre property includes a 30-acre active park with soccer fields, walking/hiking trails, a tot lot, a parking lot and restrooms and a 94-acre passive park with wetlands that will contain sections of the Potomac Heritage National Scenic Trail and Broad Run Corridor Trail. From Route 7 in Ashburn, take the Presidential Drive entrance into University Center, turn right onto George Washington Blvd., turn left onto Riverside Parkway and follow to Bles Park. 44830 Riverside Parkway in the University Center development of Ashburn.

Briar Patch Park

A five-acre park located on Sterling Boulevard. Contains three age-appropriate creative playground units, a picnic pavilion with tables, volleyball court, basketball court, and two tennis courts. Route 604 off Sterling Boulevard, Sterling

Conklin Park

A 30-acre passive and active park located on Donegal Drive near the intersection of Dabner Drive in South Riding. Amenities include basketball courts, three tennis courts, a sand volleyball court, two soccer fields, a pond and parking facilities.



Elizabeth Mills Riverfront Park

The property includes 122 acres of passive parkland with access to the Potomac River and Goose Creek. The park is home to the historic Elizabeth Mills canal lock system and will contain a section of the Potomac Heritage National Scenic Trail. From the Lansdowne Boulevard entrance, cross over Riverside Parkway, turn right onto Riverpointe Drive, turn right onto Squirrel Ridge Place. Squirrel Ridge Place leads all the way down the hill, curves alongside of the golf course, and ends at the parking lot for Elizabeth Mills. 43513 Squirrel Ridge Place Note: Kephart Bridge Landing is located within the park.

Fireman's Field

A 12-acre park located on Nursery Avenue in Purcellville which includes a lighted ballfield and a concession building.

Greg Crittenden Memorial Park

Located in Ashburn Farm at the corner of Ashburn Farm Parkway and Windmill Drive is a 16-acre park with three baseball/softball fields and a snack bar. 21401 Windmill Dr. Ashburn

Harper Park

The county's smallest park, with less than an acre of land. The old Stone House is being refurbished as part of this park, located just east of Leesburg on Route 7.

Keep Loudoun Beautiful Park

A three-point-four-acre park located adjacent to the historic Goose Creek truss bridge along Rt. 7, east of Leesburg. The park has picnic facilities and a boat launch, and is ideal for fishing.

Kephart Bridge Landing

Kephart Bridge Landing is the canoe and kayak launch facility located within Elizabeth Mills Riverfront Park at 43942 Riverpoint Drive. The landing is accessed from Riverpoint Drive. From the park, take Squirrel Ridge Drive back to Riverpoint Drive. Turn right. Continue on Riverpoint Drive and cross over Upper Belmont Place. The entrance to the landing will be on the left. From the Belmont Ridge Road entrance, cross over Riverside Parkway, turn left onto Riverpoint Drive.

Lucketts Community Park

Located just south of the Lucketts school and Community Center. Situated on ten acres of land, the park includes a soccer field, a lighted adult softball field, and a trails network. 42361 Lucketts Road, Leesburg

Nell Boone Park

A three-acre park located on Rt. 671, in the Neersville community. Park facilities include basketball and tennis courts, a children's playground and a baseball/softball field. 11762 Harper's Ferry Road
