



From New Jersey:

Take Route 202 South to Route 413. Turn right onto Route 413 for 4 2 /10 miles to Danboro-Point Pleasant Pike and turn right. Proceed 1 /4 mile to the community on your right.



From I-95:

Take Exit 49 (Newtown) to Route 332 West. Proceed 3 miles on Route 332 to where it combines with Route 413 North. Proceed on Route 413 for 17 ¹/₂ miles. Turn right onto Danboro-Point Pleasant Pike. Proceed ¹/₄ mile to the community on your right.


